The course of fire for the match on Saturday, June 22, 2019 is a NRA **Regional Match Course (7.15)** Firing will be done at 200, 300 and 600 yards using the SR, SR-3 and MR-1 high-power rifle targets. Competitors will be required to perform pit target duties or provide a substitute.

#### June 22, 2019 - NRA 80 Shot Regional Course

Stage	Distance	Type of Fire	Firing Position	Number of Shots	Time Limit
1st	200 yards	Slow	Standing	20	20 minutes
2nd	200 yards	Rapid	Sitting	20	60 seconds each string
3rd	300 yards	Rapid	Prone	20	70 seconds each string
4th	600 yards	Slow	Prone	20	20 minutes

Note: There will be a 2 shot / 2 minute sighter period for each stage of fire.

**Rifles:** Rifles used in the NRA 80 Shot Regional Course may be either a **Service Rifle 3.1**, **NRA Match Rifle 3.3**, or **NRA Any Sight Match Rifle/Tactical Rifle 3.3.2**. Rifles used in the CMP EIC match must comply with **CMP Service Rifle Rules** (Rules 6.1.1, 6.1.3, or 6.1.4).

#### June 23, 2019 - CMP Excellence-In-Competition Rifle Match (EIC Leg Match)

Stage	Distance	Type of Fire	Firing Position	Number of Shots	Time Limit
1st	200 yards	Slow	Standing	10	10 minutes
2nd	200 yards	Rapid	Sitting or Kneeling from Standing	10	60 seconds
3rd	300 yards	Rapid	Prone from Standing	10	70 seconds
4th	600 yards	Slow	Prone	20	20 minutes

**Ammunition:** Competitors must provide their own ammunition for both matches.

**Rules:** These matches are governed by NRA High Power and CMP Competition Rules.

**Number of Relays / Number of Firing Points:** 4 relays / up to 9 shooters per relay.

<b>Entry Fees:</b>	Competitors who are a current member of a Michigan, Wisconsin or other state's Shooting or Sportsmen's Club and are a NRA Member in good standing.	\$20.00 for Saturday match \$25.00 for Leg Match or \$40.00 for both matches
	All other Competitors	\$30.00 per match
	Any Junior Competitor : \$10.00 for Saturday's match and \$15.00 for the Leg Match
