## NEGAUNEE ROD & GUN CLUB

**Greetings fellow Negaunee Rod & Gun Club members—** Now that the holidays are in the rearview mirror, we're getting back into the swing of things at the Club. Read on and you'll find timely updates and details regarding a variety of events and activities that are being planned for the Club. Come out and join in the action as we take the winter months in stride!

**WINTER HOURS:** The Clubhouse hours for the winter season are as follows:

- Saturday: Noon – 5:00pm (Skeet & Trap)

**2025 MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL:** If you haven't already done so, please take some time to renew your membership. We have added a new online renewal option that is fast, easy, and secure! The Board recently adopted a revised *Release and Waiver of Liability Agreement* for the Club. The intent is to have all members and guests sign this agreement to protect the Club, and its members, from liability that may be attributable to the shooting sports or the Club's various activities. This common practice is widely recognized throughout the shooting sports industry and has been implemented at most shooting sports facilities. You will be asked to acknowledge and accept the terms and conditions of the revised agreement when you renew your membership. The revised agreement can be reviewed and accepted through the Club's website under the "Documents" tab or when you use the online membership renewal option.

**COFFEE KLATCHES:** Beginning Thursday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Clubhouse will open every Thursday morning at 9:00am for members to come out and enjoy a hot cup of coffee, the camaraderie, and some genuine *yarn spinning*. We may even fetch up some righteous breakfast grub, if there's enough interest expressed by those that show up. Come out and join your fellow members for a hot cup of Jo and storytelling as we shake off the winter doldrums.

**WILD GAME FEED & COOK-OFF:** The Annual ***Wild Game Feed and Cook-off*** will take place on **Saturday, March 1<sup>st</sup>**. Tickets are available at the Clubhouse, Wilderness Sports (Ishpeming), and Smarty's Saloon (Negaunee). Get your tickets now and hold the date for what promises to be another sold out event!

Be sure to enter your favorite wild game dish in the Cook-off Competition. The Top Prize of a \$100 Gift Card to Wilderness Sports will go to the dish that receives the highest number of votes. **MEIJER WINTER GAMES:** Once again, the Club is participating in the Meijer Winter Games after the great turnout we experienced in 2024. The Winter Games present a great opportunity to highlight our Club and the various activities we offer. The Club will host **.22 LR Rimfire Benchrest Rifle** events on **February 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>** and a **Shotgun** event on **Sunday, February 9<sup>th</sup>**.

The Shotgun event will consist of 50 Trap and 50 Skeet targets (100 target event). The .22 LR Rimfire Benchrest Rifle event will follow the format that is used for the ARA sanctioned events that have become so popular at the Club.

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to all of the "hot shots!" A large turnout is expected, so be sure to register early to secure your spot on the playing field. 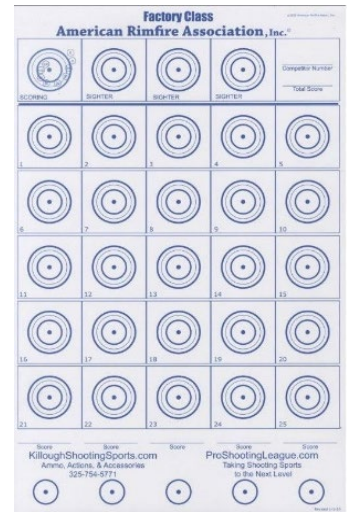

**RELOADING SWAP MEET:** Once again, the Club is holding a ***Swap Meet*** for anyone who might be interested. The event will take place on **Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup>** at the Clubhouse between the hours of 10:00am and 2:00pm. There is no charge for the event and members are encouraged to bring out any surplus reloading equipment, shooting supplies, components, or related items they'd like to sell, trade, donate, or otherwise "rehome."

**.22 LR RIMFIRE RIFLE & ARA EVENTS:** Did you know your Clubhouse is open for Indoor Rifle Shooting (rimfire only) during the winter months each Tuesday evening from 5:00 – 8:00pm? What a great opportunity to get out of the house and reduce that “cabin fever” that has spiked since the holidays! ***Please note: the Clubhouse will close early if no one shows up to shoot!***

American Rimfire Association (ARA) .22 LR Rimfire Benchrest shooting continues to grow rapidly under John Heikkila and the Rimfire Team’s leadership. You can shoot “Factory Class,” “Unlimited Class,” or both, and you’ll be amazed at the camaraderie and enjoyment you’ll experience.

The ARA format is typically shot as “3-Card”, “4-Card”, or “6-Card” events. Each card is timed and consists of twenty-five targets (~1.5” diameter for Factory Class and 1” diameter for Unlimited Class). Each target is shot using a single round of .22 LR ammunition and is scored as being between 0 and 100 points. A perfect card is scored as 2,500. The shooter’s score for the event is determined by adding the scores of each card together for a total score. A 3-Card event score of 7,500 is a unicorn and will cost you several rounds in the Clubhouse.



ARA has something for everyone, regardless of age, ability, or the type of shooting you’ve enjoyed throughout the years (rifle, pistol or shotgun). ARA matches are a frequent and regular occurrence at the NRG. **JUNIOR RIFLE:** The Junior Rifle program is “in season” at the Club under the leadership of Coach and Mentor, Robin Turner. Robin has mentored the next generation of shooters for a number of years; providing supervision, instruction, and encouragement. The Junior Rifle group meets Wednesday evenings between the hours of 6:30 – 8:00pm.

As you may have heard, Robin and his wife are relocating to South Dakota later this year. Robin will be greatly missed at the Club! As such, we are actively recruiting someone to take Robin’s place as our Junior Rifle Coach and Mentor. This is a particularly important role at the Club considering we can’t have a Junior Rifle program if we don’t have a Coach and Mentor. **F-Class 600 Yard NRA Sanctioned Matches:** The 600 yard F-Class Matches at the Club are back! What is F-Class you ask? F-Class is a long-range target rifle shooting discipline where competitors shoot at targets that are set at distances of 300 to 1,000 yards down range. F-Class is a fast-growing sport that's suitable for shooters of all ages and abilities. See the Club's calendar for specific dates and details for the F-Class matches that are planned for the year.

Two years ago, the Club adopted the ShotMarker Digital Target System to record each shooter's shots during the F-Class matches. This new system has enhanced our NRA Sanctioned, 60 Round Matches. As a result, National Class shooters continue to attend our matches. The competition is fierce among the highly skilled shooters and the matches are frequently decided by X-Count. Spectators are always welcome! The matches can be watched using the interactive ShotMarker Digital Target System. If you're interested in learning more about F-Class, come out to the Club to watch one of the F-Class matches that are scheduled during 2025, including the ***Open Championship*** which will be held on **Saturday, September 13<sup>th</sup>** or email Greg Erkkila at [gerkkila333@gmail.com](mailto:gerkkila333@gmail.com).

**HIGH POWER RIFLE SHOOTING:** This spring and summer, the rifle range will be open for anyone who would like to come out and try the Club's ShotMarker Digital Target system. If you're interested in shooting targets that are set as far as 600 yards downrange, come join us Tuesday evenings from 4:00 – 6:00pm. Tuesdays are a great opportunity to extend your effective shooting range or become familiar with F-Class Shooting. We have a consistent group of shooters that turn out weekly who can help you with the ShotMarker System and get you shooting on target and consistently hitting the X-Ring.

**MID UP CLAY CRUSHERS:** In 2024, the Mid UP Clay Crushers Youth Trap Team was established for youth that want to develop their skills and compete in the shooting sports. The Youth Trap Team is affiliated with the Scholastic Clay Target program and is coached by Mike Ansell and Assistant Coaches Ken Goldsworthy, Terry Jandreau and Scott Jensen.

These young guns are currently practicing on Saturday mornings beginning at Noon (weather permitting) as they prepare to compete during the 2025 season. **WINTER SHOTGUN SHOOTING:** The Mid-UP Shooters (aka shotgun shooters or “MUPS”) have long held the tradition of spending the winter months grinding clay targets into dust at the range. Winter conditions present the perfect opportunity to hone your skills under adverse weather conditions. The Skeet and Trap fields are open each Saturday at Noon for use by all members. Grab your favorite shotgun and a few boxes of shells and head on out to hone those shotgun shooting skills.

MUPS is actively encouraging the next generation of shooting sports enthusiasts to “get in the game.” To accomplish this goal, MUPS is allowing our young shooters through the age of 18 to shoot up to 50 clay targets per week (typically, 2 rounds of Skeet or Trap) at no cost. For more information, or to introduce a prospective young shooter to the shooting sports, head out to the Club on Saturday afternoons where you’ll find a number of MUPS members in the Clubhouse or on the Skeet or Trap field yelling “PULL!” They’ll show you the ropes and get you busting clays before you know it!

**YOOPER SIDE-BY-SIDE CLASSIC:** The Fifth Annual Yooper Side-By-Side Classic shotgun extravaganza will be held at the Club later this summer. This event offers endless opportunities to share your passion for fine guns and the shooting sports with likeminded sportsmen and sportswomen from across the nation. The Main Event will be held on Friday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> and Saturday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> and features a 72 bird Super Sporting Clays course; 72 bird Hunter’s Challenge Sporting Clays course; 25 bird Pigeon Ring; and 30 bird Upland Game Walk. The Main Event must be shot with a side-by-side shotgun (vintage and gauge are shooter’s choice).

A ***Pre-event Fun Shoot*** will also be held on **Thursday, August 21<sup>st</sup>**. The fun shoot is open to all members and the general public and can be shot with any style of shotgun (side-by-side, over/under, semi-auto, pump).

Mid-UP Shooters is also hosting a ***Special Youth Division*** event on **Thursday, August 21<sup>st</sup>**, in conjunction with the Yooper Side-by-Side Classic extravaganza. The Youth Division is open to any young shooter that is 17 years of age or younger and is knowledgeable of the shooting sports. There is NO COST to participate; however, participants must provide ammo and a shotgun they intend to use for the event, and they must be accompanied by an adult that is knowledgeable of the shooting sports and range etiquette. The Youth Division course will consist of 50 clay targets (25 Sporting Clays, 15 Upland Game Walk and 10 Pigeon Ring). Lunch is included and each participant will receive a prize! **MILITARY RIFLE MATCHES:** Do you have an old military rifle sitting in your gun cabinet that you may have received from your grandpa or dad that hasn't seen the light of day since you got it? Well then, bring it out to the Club and join others that have similar equipment and compete in games that are geared just for your special rifle and equipment.

We have scheduled four military matches throughout the year that will test your skills and give you a sense for what it's like to shoot under simulated combat conditions.

The first match will take place on **March 8<sup>th</sup>** and is the ***Soumi Shoot*** where we will reenact the Finnish – Russian War of 1939 (aka as the “Winter War” or the Battle of Suomussalmi). The Winter War began on November 30, 1939, when the Soviet's 163<sup>rd</sup> Rifle Division crossed the border between Finland and the Soviet Union and advanced from the north-east towards the village of Suomussalmi. The war continued until January 8, 1940, at which time the outcome was declared a Finnish victory over the superior forces of the Soviet Union. The Soumi Shoot reenacts the Soviet Union's advance into Finland and the overwhelming Finnish response. Paper targets of various sizes and distances will be engaged by the participants as they move about and fire from various shooting positions. *Warning: be sure to bring your SISU to this match as weather and conditions play a vital role in determining the outcome!*

The second match is our ***Vintage D-DAY Match***. This match will take place on **Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup>** and honors all who stormed the Normandy beaches during that fateful day long ago. Targets will be set at distances from 25 to 300 yards and include bowling pins, steel plates, paper targets, water bottles, and a sandbag bunker.

The third match is the ***Military 100yd Benchrest Match***. This match will take place on **Sunday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>**. Participants will engage four (4) targets that are set at a distance of 100 yards under timed conditions; either slow or rapid fire.

The fourth match is the ***Civilian Marksmanship Competition*** or CMP Match. This event will be held on **Saturday, September 6<sup>th</sup>** and consists of 35 rounds that will be fired at electronic targets that are set at a distance of 200 yards. Each participant will shoot 5 sighters and 30 shots for record. Basically, this event is designed to mimic one of the competitions that a shooter might participate in at the National Matches that are held at Camp Perry ANG, Port Clinton, Ohio.

For those of you that have older military rifles that shoot 30-06 ammo, we have surplus ammo for sale at very reasonable prices that you can use at the military rifle matches.

**CIVILIAN MARKSMAN PROGRAM:** Did you know your Club is affiliated with the Civilian Marksmanship Program (aka CMP)? Because the Club is recognized by the CMP, and provides Club members with an opportunity to compete in sponsored matches, qualified participants can purchase US Government surplus rifles, pistols, ammo, and shooting supplies and have those items delivered directly to them.

The CMP traces its origins back to 1903 when President Theodore Roosevelt recognized the need to improve upon the marksmanship of the civilian shooting community throughout the nation. As noted above, the Club hosts a CMP match every year (scheduled for Saturday, September 6<sup>th</sup>) to qualify individuals that are interested in joining the CMP. **PISTOL OPPORTUNITIES:** Did you know your Clubhouse is open for Indoor Pistol Shooting (rimfire only) each Monday evening from 5:00 – 8:00pm during the winter months? Here's another great opportunity to get out of the house to shake off those winter blues! ***Please note: the Clubhouse will close early if no one shows up to shoot!***

The Pistol Committee has been working hard at improving the Club's pistol range and developing new events. This past year we added some additional steel targets at distances of 10 to 25 yards. We also held several matches during 2024 that were quite popular and brought a number of shooters out to the range.

During 2025, the ever-popular ***Firecracker 300*** will be held on **Sunday, July 13<sup>th</sup>** so mark your calendars now and make plans to attend. We also plan to hold at least three .22 LR Rimfire Steel Plate Challenge matches. You can use either a .22 LR Rimfire Pistol or Rifle (or both) to shoot the course – you get to choose. The Steel Plate Challenges are intended to be fun events that offer something for everyone (and the ammo won't deplete your life's savings)!

We will continue to enhance the Club's pistol range during 2025. We will be adding some crushed rock in front of the storage shed and rain gutters to the building to help manage the runoff that tends to accumulate in that area. We will also be adding some smaller shooting tables for the pistol shooters that can be easily moved to accommodate different shooting styles. Stay tuned!
